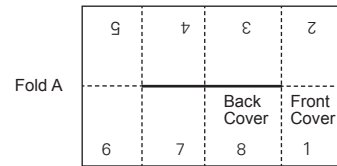

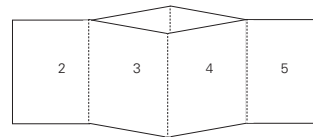

## Make Lots of Books!

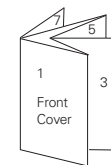
Fold this sheet into your very own "Hidden" book. First, fold on all dotted lines. Then cut a slit on the center solid line shown below.
